

1963, Camelback Mountain Resort, opened in the region with 14 trails and three lifts that served 41,656 skiers. Today, by comparison, Camelback serves nearly a million skiers and outdoor recreationists annually with 34 trails and 16 lifts.

Camelback grew throughout the 2000s, adding the Camelback Lodge and Aquatopia Indoor Waterpark in 2015.

Camelback also enhanced its popular snow-tubing hill—already the country’s largest at 42 lanes—by adding Galactic Tubing, a nighttime attraction that lights the hills with an LED show.

Camelback Mountain has a new wall of history created, for their 60th Anniversary. In addition, there is a display cabinet which contains items from the PA SnowSports Museum. Both are located in the ski area base lodge.
